

PRESIDENT OF PAKISTAN OSP N. CHRISTY GOLD MEDAL FOR THE YEAR 2016

The recipient of the N. Christy Gold Medal for the year 2016 is a Pakistani Ophthalmologist, born in 1957. He passed his M.B.B.S in 1982, did Diploma in Ophthalmology from Glasgow, UK in 1988, obtained FRCS in Ophthalmology from Edinburgh in 1990 and was awarded FRCOphth.

After going through numbers of jobs in prestigious hospitals in UK, the recipient came back to his native country and was appointed as Associate Professor at Jinnah Postgraduate Medical Centre, Karachi.

The recipient is a senior and life member of Ophthalmological Society of Pakistan. The recipient has been regularly attending many national, regional and international ophthalmic conferences, where he has been regularly presenting his original scientific work.

One of his aim in his professional life is to serve the under privileged populations in the remote areas of the interior Sind and also conducted a free eye camp in East Africa as a team leader.

The recipient is a devoted and dedicated teacher as well as examiner both for undergraduate and postgraduate students in ophthalmology and supervisor for MCPS & FCPS. He has also regularly publishing his research work in various indexed journals of ophthalmology.
