

## OSP MUKHTAR AHMAD GOLD MEDAL

The OSP Mukhtar Ahmad Gold Medal for year 2016 goes to a distinguished Pakistani Ophthalmologist, borne in 1959. He graduated from Rawalpindi Medical College in 1983, did Diploma in Ophthalmology from Armed Forces Postgraduate Medical Institute in 1988 and FCPS in Ophthalmology from College of Physicians & Surgeons Pakistan in 1990.

During his career, he has served on different position in different medical institutions of Armed Forces and eventually reached to the position of Professor & Head Department of Ophthalmology CMH, Lahore. The recipient is well reputed country wide for his advanced surgical skills especially in Cataract, Refractive Surgery & Premium IOL implants. The awardee observes excellent ethical profile with no patient complaint or any disciplinary action on issues pertaining to patient management, ethically, morally, technically or financially during entire career of about 32 years.

Apart from being a very kind, caring and competent ophthalmologist, the recipient has been a very dedicated and devoted teacher both at undergraduate and postgraduate levels for the last 21 years. He is also a keen research worker. He has so far published 12 papers and many case reports in various national and international journals.

As part of his keen interest in academics, the recipient has actively participated in 82 national and international workshops / conferences in which he has presented 50 papers/ presentation on different aspects of ophthalmology.
