

OSP PRESIDENT OF PAKISTAN, RAMZAN ALI SYED GOLD MEDAL

The OSP President of Pakistan, Ramzan Ali Syed Gold Medal for the Year 2016 is awarded to an Ophthalmologist who graduated in Medicine from Liaquat University of Medical and Health Sciences, Jamshoro. He did sub-specialty training in Glaucoma and Medical Retina at Royal Alexandra Hospital / Western Infirmary, Glasgow, Scotland. The recipient is a fellow of Royal College of Ophthalmologists, U.K.

He was appointed Professor of Ophthalmology, Isra Postgraduate Institute of Ophthalmology. He is also consultant Ophthalmic Surgeon at Aga Khan University Hospital, Karachi. The recipient is also President of Pakistan Glaucoma Association (PGA), and he initiated annual sub-specialty conference on Glaucoma. The awardee is clinical reviewer for 8 national & international index journals.

The recipient got Distinguished Service Award by Asia Pacific Academy of Ophthalmology in 2014 and was also awarded Gold Medal for Services in Ophthalmology by Faisalabad branch of OSP.

Apart from being a very kind, caring and competent ophthalmologist, the recipient has been a very dedicated and devoted teacher and keen research worker. He so far presented nearly 150 presentations in National and International Conference and published about 45 papers in peer-reviewed journals.
